PRACTICE QUESTIONS

1. Clayton earns an hourly wage of \$6.00 per hour and time-and-a-half for overtime. If he worked 34 hours, what are his wages for the first week?
2. During the second week, Clayton worked 43.5 hours. What are his wages for the second week including overtime pay?
3. During the third week, Clayton worked 47 hours. What are his wages for the third week?
4. Clayton is keeping a record of his wages and wants to know his average pay per hour (rounded to the nearest cent) for the first three weeks. Can you help him?
5. Abigail is being paid a weekly salary at \$11.75 per hour. What can she expect her salary to be for 50 weeks if her contract is for 40 hours of life-guarding each week?
6. Abigail is paid a \$27,000 salary per year. About how much money per hour does she make? (Assume 50 weeks of 40 hours each for a simplified estimate.)

7. Alex just sold his first house as a real estate salesman. His commission is 1.5%. The house sold for \$179,500. How much money in commissions did Alex receive from the sale?

8. Christiana is being paid 11¢ for each DVD she places in a jacket with the paper insert. Last week she finished eight cases of 100 in six hours. How much money did she make altogether? What was her average pay per hour rounded to the nearest cent?

PRACTICE QUESTIONS

1. James earns an hourly wage of \$10.75 per hour and time-and-a-half for overtime. If James worked 38.5 hours, what are his wages (rounded to the nearest cent) for the first week he worked?
2. During the second week, James worked 51 hours. What are his wages for the second week rounded to the nearest cent?
3. During the third week, James worked 48.25 hours. What are his wages for the third week rounded to the nearest cent?
4. James is keeping a record of his pay. He wants to know his average pay per hour (rounded to the nearest cent) for the first three weeks. Can you help him?
5. John is being paid a weekly salary at \$18.33 per hour and 40 hours per week. What can he expect his salary to be for 50 weeks?
6. Isaac is being paid a \$44,500 salary per year. About how much money per hour does Isaac make? (Assume 50 weeks of 40-hours each for a simplified estimate.)

PRACTICE QUESTIONS

1. Story earns an hourly wage of \$7.50 an hour. If she worked 25 hours, what is her pay for the week? During the second week, Story worked a total of 41 hours. What is her pay for the second week?
2. Anora receives a weekly salary for 40 hours per week at \$8.25 per hour. Estimate her yearly income. (Use 50 weeks for the year to keep the estimate simple).
3. Cassie-Marie receives an annual salary of \$52,500.00. About how much money per hour does she make? (Assume 50 weeks of 40-hours each to keep the estimate simple.)
4. Aimee just sold a set of encyclopedias for \$950.00. Her commission is 15%. How much money did Aimee receive for this sale?
5. Maddie receives 45¢ for each set of inserts she assembles. She assembled 83 sets in 3 hours and 30 minutes. How much did money she earn? What was her hourly rate?
6. Would you rather receive a salary, be paid a commission for your work, or a combination of both? What are the advantages of each method of being recompensed for your efforts?

7. Debbie sells new cars. The price of an average new vehicle at her dealership is \$23,000.00 and the profit for the dealership is \$1,260.00 per car. Debbie receives a 25% commission on the dealership's profit for each car she sells. How much did she make when she sold seven cars in four weeks?

8. Debbie also receives a base salary of \$450.00 each week. What is Debbie's total salary (base salary plus commissions) for the four weeks?

2. Julia receives a weekly salary for 40 hours each week at \$23.00 per hour. If she puts in 50 weeks, what is her salary?
3. According to her employment contract, Olivia will receive an annual salary of \$75,000. Estimate the equivalent amount of money per hour. (Assume 50 weeks of 40 hours each to keep it simple.)
4. Anna found a buyer for a bread machine. The retail price is \$375.00 and her commission is 24%. How much money did she make on the sale?
5. Lauren receives \$1.25 for each block set she assembles. She assembled 28 sets in 2 hours and 45 minutes. How much money did she earn? What was her average pay per hour rounded to the nearest cent?
6. Would you rather be paid by the hour or by the piece? What are some advantages of each method of payment?

7. The studio offered Omar two options for his role as the lead actor in a movie. They would pay him a flat fee of \$50,000.00 or a base pay of \$10,000.00 plus 1% of the revenue generated from the sales from the first year. In his last feature film, the box office profit for the first year was \$6,500,000.00. If this film is equally successful, which is the more lucrative option?

8. Omar does not need the money, so he made an offer to receive a commission of 1.5% of the revenue with no base fee. If the film generates a profit of \$6,500,000.00, what will his commission be?

2. The third week Cyrus put in 42.5 hours. What is his average weekly salary for the three weeks?
3. If Mercy receives \$13.25 per hour consistently working 40 hours each week, estimate how much she can expect to earn in one year.
4. Last year Sarah earned \$39,000.00. What was her average hourly wage if she worked an average of 40 hours per week?
5. Jacob just took home his first commission check. He agreed to help Laban sell the family farm for 3% of the sale price. The selling price of the farm was 180,000 dinars. How many dinars did Jacob earn as his commission?

6. Lot is selling real estate for his uncle Abraham. He is being paid a base salary of 240 shekels per month and a 1.5% commission on each sale. The first month he sold his first property near Gomorrah valued at 13,950 shekels. What was his take home pay for the month?

7. Rebekah is paid 0.25 dinars for each goat that she cares for by giving it water and grain. In four hours, she provided for 236 goats. How many dinars did she receive for her faithful labors?

8. Daniel just sold his first set of Bible story books for \$160.00. He makes a 35% commission on each set he sells. How much did he earn on this sale?
