1. At the restaurant, Faith's bill came to \$37.25. She left an 18% tip. How much money did the waiter receive if she computed the tip just on the food without the tax? The tax was 5% of the cost of the food. How much did the tax add to the bill?
2. Faith likes to pay in round numbers. What should she add to the tip in number 1 to make the final bill just dollars and no cents? What is the final tally?
3. This week Rachel and Ernest went to an "all-you-can-eat" spaghetti dinner. Ernest ate three plates of noodles and sauce. The bill was \$26.95 for the two of them. How much is a 20% tip? The sales tax was 7%. How much did this add to their bill?
4. What was the final bill for the spaghetti dinner? Add a little extra for the server and round up to the nearest dollar.
5. Isaac received a bill on May 17 for \$874.50. On the bottom of invoice is a line that reads "1% 10 net 30." It is now May 23. How much should he pay?
6. Isaac had an invoice come in for \$1,358.00. On the bill it said "2% 15 net 30." It has been twenty-five days since he received the bill. Is he able to take advantage of the discount? If so, how much would he save?

2. Savannah prefers to pay in even dollars. How much did she add to the bill to round up to the nearest dollar?
3. For Anna's birthday, she went to Carrumbbas Restaurant. The bill was \$93.20. How much would a 15% tip come to? The sales tax was 7.25%. How much did this add to the bill?
4. What is the final tally for the meal at Carrumbbas, including the tax and tip? Round the answer to the nearest dollar.
5. A bill was received on August 9 for \$1,299.00. On the invoice is a note that said "1% 10 net 30." It is now August 20th. How much should be sent?
6. An invoice came for \$265.00. On the bill it said "2% 10 net 30." It has been seven days since this was received this in the mail. How much should be paid if the payment is sent in today?
